<u>Clean Foods</u> are those items which in their natural state do not harm the human body and which man can use for his nourishment.

<u>The Unclean</u> (commonly mistaken as "foods") are those items which are unhealthy to consume and are poisonous to the body.

The Scriptures discuss the topic of what foods are good and bad for Man to eat in Leviticus 11 and Deuteronomy 14.

Scriptural Versus Regarding The Unclean, Not Listed By Category Below

Lev 5:2 'Or when a being touches any unclean matter, or the carcass of an unclean beast, or the carcass of unclean livestock, or the carcass of unclean creeping creatures, and it has been hidden from him, he is unclean and guilty.

Lev 5:3 'Or when he touches uncleanness of man, any of his uncleanness by which he is unclean, and it has been hidden from him, when he shall know it, then he shall be guilty.

Lev 7:18 'However, if any of the flesh of his peace offering is eaten at all on the third day, it is not accepted. It is not reckoned to him who brings it, it is unclean to him, and the being who eats of it bears his crookedness.

Lev 7:19 'And the flesh that touches that which is unclean is not eaten, it is burned with fire. And as for the clean flesh, all who are clean eat of it.

These laws are known as health laws, and are the means for achieving a healthier life.

[Scripturally, these instructions come from Torah, which means "instructions", "guidelines", "teachings", and some say "Laws", the first five books of the Pre-Messianic Covenant aka New Testament.]

In the beginning, man ate fruits and vegetables according to YAHWEH's instruction, but later started eating meat [after the 40-day flood of Noah's time]; the food from plants after The Flood no longer had all of the health sustaining characteristics as they did prior to The Flood. YAHWEH made known what meats where unhealthy through the laws of clean and unclean foods long before there was a nation of Yisra'ĕl, even before Noah's time, as seen in Genesis 7:2 and 7:8.

It is a well know fact today, that these same unclean foods are known to be unhealthy.

But you say, what about the following verse from scripture?

Deu 12:15 "Only, whatever your being desires you shall slaughter and eat, according to the blessing of יהוה your Elohim which He has given you, within all your gates. The unclean and the clean do eat of it, of the gazelle [roebuck] and the deer [hart] alike.

This is one of the most misinterpreted verses on this subject, because of the food laws being well know in their nation they did not keep unclean animals around for food, so they would not have found it in their gates. It is speaking of the unclean person eating with the clean person during this time. Normally, an unclean person was not allowed to eat with those that where clean.

Deu 15:22 "Eat it within your gates – the unclean and the clean alike – as the gazelle [roebuck], and as the deer [hart].

How clear it becomes now.

We should take note that these are very clearly laws to be obeyed.

Isa 66:17 those who set themselves apart and cleanse themselves at the gardens after 'One' in the midst, eating flesh of pigs and the abomination and the mouse, are snatched away, together," declares הוה.

As shown with this verse YAHWEH does condemn those that eat of what is considered an abomination. Isaiah 65:4 tells us that eating swine and other abominable things provokes the Eloah to anger.

For those that would say these laws where only for the people of Yisra'ĕl at that time, take note that animals where regarded as clean or unclean during the time of Noah (Gen 7:2) before Yisra'ĕl existed.
